# **ULPA YEAR 1 APPRENTICESHIP SYLLABUS**

### **About This Course**

When quizzes are submitted, your grade will immediately appear, and any incorrect answers will be marked. You must receive a score of at least 70% to pass each quiz and the Final Exam.

Training that cannot be completed in-house must be arranged with your employer. If a certificate is received upon completion, upload it to the assignment. If no certificate is given, download the provided one or upload a photo of evidence of completion.

Any certifications earned during this first year need to be uploaded.

\*You cannot access the final exam until all certificates and certifications are uploaded.\*

## Final Assessment/Course Completion

The Final Exam will be unlocked once you have completed all quizzes and assignments. Once you pass it with a score of at least 70%, you will receive a course completion certificate and be eligible for enrollment in Year 2!
